What the symbols mean

D.S. al Fine

This appears at the end of measure 25.

It means to go back to the dal segno sign 𝄋 (measure 10) and repeat until the point marked Fine (measure 17).

𝄋 D.S.

D.S. stands for the Italian phrase Dal Segno. (pronounced "dahl senyo").

It means "from the sign".

When D.S. appears in a music score it means go back to the Dal segno sign and repeat this section.

Fine

This simply means "the end" or finale.
